

Web-Based Training Demo Access Instructions

Step 1:

- From any Internet capable location, type <http://mediationworks.com/webtraining/> in the address field at the top of your web browser window.

Step 2:

- Click 'Login' or the name of the course, in this case, 'Demonstration.'
 - If you are a new user, you must complete the New Account form on the right side of the screen.
 - If you are an returning user, you must login using your username and password.
Note: You must create a new account for each of the three demo modules.
 - If you would like to demo all three modules. The modules are:
 - 1) Managing Workplace Conflict - Module 1: Necessary Knowledge – Demo

- Click key icon or the name of the course.
