

## CT Network Reseller Agreement

Active External CTs, and Internal CTs who elect to provide training for hire for organizations other than their employer, may act as resellers under this agreement to contract for delivery of Seminars directly with their clients.

In the role of reseller, the CT understands that the Network Purchase Order (NPO) form is the sole mechanism for acquiring the tangible and intangible properties inherent to the Seminar (“Seminar Properties”), including:

1. The intellectual property residing in the content of the Seminar,
2. Participant materials (workbooks, sourcebooks, and other learning-support items),
3. Instructional aids (PowerPoint presentations, video, and instructor guides), and
4. Ongoing development and improvement of participant materials and instructional aids to ensure that exceptional value is received by learners.

Specifically, the CT recognizes that the purchase is not solely of tangible participant materials. Indeed, participant materials are not available for purchase apart from the remaining Seminar Properties. Purchase as a reseller enables the CT to supplement Seminar Properties with live instructional delivery.

Conditions of sale of Seminar Properties under this NPO:

1. By using the NPO, the CT is purchasing Seminar Properties for the purpose of reselling the acquired Seminar Properties to clients and providing live classroom instruction for an additional fee of his/her choosing.
2. The CT, or the CT's consulting firm or other proprietary entity, is the buyer of record who will be invoiced upon receipt of the NPO. The NPO is not for use by the CT's client organization.
3. CTs are expected to ask seminar participants to complete the evaluation form in their workbooks, or an equivalent form, and to send results to MTI as a quality assurance measure.
4. By submitting the NPO form, the CT acknowledges and accepts these conditions of sale.
5. MTI reserves the right to modify this Reseller Agreement. Any negotiations or contracts between CTs and their clients that are in progress at the time of discontinuance will be honored by MTI.
